She was a Graphic Designer at the Carrillo Gil Museum of Contemporary Art and Programming Coordinator of the Festival of the Historic Center of Mexico City, she collaborated as assistant director at the Marlborough Gallery in Madrid, she coordinated the exhibitions of the DV Gallery in San Sebastián, she was the Responsible for Communication and External Relations of the European Biennial of Contemporary Art Manifesta 5, which took place in San Sebastián in 2004, Coordinator of the Sales Office of the 54th edition of the Donostia-San Sebastián International Film Festival and responsible for the exhibition Dimension Sonora at the Koldo Mitxelena Cultural Center in San Sebastián. She assumed the position of International Affairs of the National Coordination of Plastic Arts of INBA in the Secretariat of Culture of the Government of Mexico. Later she was responsible for the Head of International Affairs of the Coordination of Cultural Diffusion of the National Autonomous University of Mexico, UNAM, and for 11 years, Deputy Director of Communication, Editions and Interinstitutional Relations of the General Directorate of Visual Arts and the University Museum Art Contemporary, MUAC, from UNAM in Mexico City.
