Carmen Ruiz Garcia holds a degree in Graphic Design, and she has been dedicated to culture, especially contemporary art in Mexico and Spain for more than 30 years.

She was a graphic designer for the Museo de Arte Contemporáneo Carrillo Gil and programming coordinator for the Festival Centro Histórico in Mexico City. She collaborated as assistant manager at the Marlborough Gallery in Madrid, and in Donostia-San Sebastián, she was responsible for exhibitions at the DV Gallery, responsible for communication and external relations for the European Biennial of Contemporary Art, Manifesta 5 in 2004 and coordinated the sales office of the 54th edition of the International Film Festival and the *Dimension Sonora* exhibition at the Koldo Mitxelena Cultural Centre.

She held the position of international affairs of the National Coordination of Plastic Arts at the Government of Mexico Ministry of Culture. She takes charge of the international affairs department of the National Autonomous University of Mexico, UNAM at the Coordination of Cultural Diffusion, and assumes the direction of communication, editions, and inter-institutional relations, for 12 years, in the General Direction of Visual Arts and the Museo Universitario Arte Contemporáneo, MUAC - UNAM, in Mexico City.
